ntroductory word



Dear colleagues, dear students,

as the newly appointed Dean of the Faculty of Science, Palacký University in Olomouc, I would like to thank all of those who motivated me, supported my candidacy, and convinced me that it is possible to handle even more work and responsibilities than I have had so far. At the same time I would like to accentuate that this is a great challenge and a great commitment for me, which I absolutely do not underestimate. Therefore, as I have stated in my election program, I will do my best in order for the faculty to comply with the international level of quality and to move yet a little bit closer to international recognition. During the past few years, thanks to all acquired grants, the Faculty was able to reinforce the research and educational infrastructure, and the staff of individual departments in an immense way. For the following term it is necessary to complement this growth with efficient organizational support and use it to improve and streamline all of our activities, from the building maintenance, organization of educational activities up to the production of high quality publications, and patenting of the research results.

Along with the dynamic development of our research infrastructure and with the growing prestige of our research groups, we do not want to neglect our students many of whom are involved in those activities. The Faculty provides a highly modern environment and laboratory equipment for the students to study and do their training. Therefore, I would like to ask our students, who form a substantial part of the academic community, to approach their education with responsibility, and to take advantage of all the opportunities offered by guaranteeing departments. I wish them a lot of success and achievements in the upcoming summer semester. You have certainly noticed that I have chosen only three of my colleagues for the Vice-Dean positions. I know them very well and I also know that I can absolutely rely on them. I have appointed a young and energetic biologist Prof. Zdeněk Dvořák as the Vice-Dean for Science and Research. I have entrusted a physicist, an experienced teacher, and a former long-time Faculty and University Senator Dr. Roman Kubínek with the administration of studies, education, and social matters. And the field of external cooperation has been attributed to a mathematician and a respected teacher Prof. Josef Molnár, who has a Vice-Dean experience from the two previous terms already. It is my intention to eventually complete this team with highly qualified professionals on the managerial posts at the Dean's office in order to allow the academic management of the Faculty to focus on long-term development and directing of the Faculty rather than on exhausting day-to-day administrative routine.

Today, just before the beginning of the summer semester, I would like to introduce a new source of information of the Faculty of Science which strives to unite the advantages of its predecessors "The Friday Letter"(Pátečník) and "The Monday Letter" (Pondělník). It does not carry an original title such as "The Wednesday Letter" (Středečník), although it has been proposed, but it is simply called the Newsletter of the Faculty of Science, Palacký University. Besides the usual information sections and the bilingual design which is, thanks to a number of international faculty staff, absolutely necessary these days, we would like to give space to individual departments for their short presentations and original introductory entries.

I would be pleased if you read the Newsletter (with delight) occasionally.

The IGA UP Grant Competition 2014 – 2015

The evaluation of project applications for projects starting from 1th March 2015 is presently under way. The estimated total amount of funding allocated at the Faculty of Science is about CZK 37,150,000. The budget of individual IGA projects will be decided on the basis of the number of so called RIV points (points allocated to research publications, patents, etc.) obtained by the particular department in five year period. Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports has not provided data for the year 2012 yet. Due to the technical reasons it is therefore not possible to allocate IGA UP grants based on points obtained in the period of 2008 – 2012, but the rating of the period 2007 – 2011, the same as last year, will be used. Individual project managers can get more exact idea about particular allocations from the last year's RIV point distribution and the total amount assigned to the Faculty. The Grant Council, which will finally approve the allocations, will be held on 24th February 2014. The Science and Research Department will subsequently inform the project managers about exact amounts and changes in the budget for individual project chapters (increases/cuts) will be settled also.

Institutional Funding for Research (RVO)

We expect to receive the RIV points 2012 data from the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports in the second half of February. We expect the total amount of RVO funding to reach CZK 215,868,000 for the Faculty of Science. The Science and Research Department will ask the heads of the individual departments to check the RIV points and possibly their allocation afterwards. FRUP Projects (Development fund)

According to the guidelines of the Bursar from the 4th February 2014, it is possible to draw the allocated financial resources of the already approved FRUP Projects.

Registration on courses for the summer semester of academic year 2013/2014

Registration of courses for Bachelor (Bc.) and follow-up Master (NMgr) study programs for the summer semester of academic year 2013/2014 ends on 24th February 2014.

Dates of the final state examinations (SZZ) and the obligation to conclude the studies

Dates of the final state examinations, the defence of the final thesis including, are available at STAG and students can sign up like for regular exams. Students are obliged to formally conclude theirs studies at least 3 weeks before the final exams!! at the relevant study official at the Department of Studies. It is necessary to bring evidence of all exams in student's credit book. Without the conclusion of the studies at the Department of Studies one cannot be admitted to the final exams. The mentioned terms are essential in order to verify fulfilled study obligations and to prepare the protocols for final exams.

The defence of Bachelors or Master thesis takes place as a part of the final state examinations. The dates of the final thesis defence are listed by departments in the STAG system and students can sign up like for regular exams. The dates for submission of the final thesis are set by the respective department; however students are obliged to upload

the thesis into STAG at least 3 weeks before defending., otherwise it is not possible to defend the final thesis. The period is essential for the plagiarism check of the essays in the system. We recommend to get informed beforehand about the deadlines of submitting the final thesis in the summer semester at the particular departments.

Investment project of the Faculty of Science 2014-2015

Completed projects and projects before completion

Centre of the Region Haná for Biotechnological and Agricultural Research



The investment part of the project OP RD&I priority axis 2 -Centre of the Region Haná for Biotechnological and Agricultural Research was completed on 31th December 2013. The main project manager is prof. Ivo Frébort. The construction of the buildings, the laboratory equipment and the Centre's operation on the premises of the Faculty of Science in Holice campus was supported by the European Union funds and the state budget in the amount of CZK 808 million. Obligatory monitoring indicators were fulfilled and they will be included in the final monitoring report together with other specifications regarding the management and operation of the Centre before 28th February 2014. Operation sustainability of the Centre is supported by a new NPU I grant for the following 5 years, total funding amounts to CZK 393 million.

Regional Centre of Advanced Technologies and Materials



The Regional Centre of Advanced Technologies and Materials is another of OP RD&I priority axis 2 projects headed by the main project manager prof. Radek Zbořil. This project is going to be completed on 30th September 2014; however obligatory monitoring indicators have been fulfilled already. An application for the NPU I grant has been submitted to maintain sustainability of the Centre.

Project in realization The Stronghold of Knowledge




The Stronghold of Knowledge Project is another OP RD&I project, priority axis 3 with the main project manager prof. Lubomír Dvořák. The project has received financial support in the amount of 142 million CZK and is running up to 30th November 2014. However, the construction has been suspended, and Palacký University withdrew from the agreement with the construction company, which is currently in insolvency. Meanwhile 75 million CZK from the grant have been spent. The modified time schedule, which is being worked on intensely now, relies on the extension of project realization until 28th February 2015, finalization of the construction in October and opening to public in December of this year.

The Centre of Biological Fields

The last one from the infrastructure projects OP RD&I of the Faculty of Science is the project The Centre of Biological Fields (CENBIOL) subordinated priority axis 4. Its main project manager is Dr. Vladan Ondřej and total subsidy reaches CZK 95 million and additional participation share of the Faculty of Science UP



in the amount of CZK 20 million. The project CENBIOL incorporates the reconstruction of so called "GŠK" building in Holice campus, the greenhouse RD1, and the car parking. The tender for a constructor is in progress at the moment. Realization runs according to the schedule, the finalization of the project is planned on 30th June 2015.



Park in Holice campus




A new park on the premises of the Faculty of Science in Holice will be created in the time period from April to September 2014. Dr. David Cigánek from the Botanical Garden has become the project manager of the OP Environment with a grant in amount of CZK 7.5 million, including the contribution from the Faculty that should not exceed CZK 2.5 million. The tender for a constructor is in progress now in accordance with the schedule.

Environmental Centre

Reconstruction of the building situated in our Botanical Garden is planned from September 2014 to May 2015. The main author of the grant application from OP Environment in amount of CZK 13 million (contribution from the Faculty CZK 1.6 million) is again Dr. David Cigánek.




Relocation of garage and technic shed



In terms of budget planning in 2013 CZK 0.5 million was allocated towards the relocation and renovation of garages and construction of a technical shed. Estimated total cost is CZK 2.2 million. This action is necessary for realization of the CENBIOL Project.

Bicycle shed



The amount of CZK 0.5 million was approved within the 2013 budget for the construction of a bicycle shed in Holice as well.

Projects stopped before the application submission

Kindergarten on the premises of the Faculty of Science in Holice



The project preparation of the kindergarten construction in Holice from the Regional operational program with the budget of CZK 14 million (participation share of the Faculty of Science 3 million CZK) in collaboration with the statutory town of Olomouc was suspended in December 2013 due to the lot agreement expiration and extremely tight schedule. The project included construction of one-class kindergarten building and its consequent rent and operation by the Faculty of Science UP. The project can be revised and submitted again in the next programming period.
