This time we pass the introductory word of the Newsletter to the Head of the Faculty Library, who kindly responded to a call from the previous issue and is presenting the library of our faculty in his contribution below.

Dear colleagues, dear students,

The library of the Faculty of Science is an essential part of our faculty, although it falls under the Library of Palacký University, located in the Armory building at Biskupské náměstí. Our faculty has in fact two libraries, one on the 6th floor of the Faculty of Science at Envelopa, and the other one located next to the canteen in Holice premises.



The library's mission is to contribute to the fulfillment of the essential tasks of PU, to develop its educational as well as scientific and research function in particular. We are trying to achieve that goal by providing a wide range of documents and a quality service.

Most documents nowadays are no longer in the traditional printed form only, we can offer a variety of electronic books or specialized databases – electronic information resources, that give you an access to a wide spectrum of knowledge mainly in fields of natural science.

Printed books and magazines, however, still represent the fundamental part of the library. We obtain them due to the funds of the Dean's Office, and funds and grants from individual departments of the faculty. Therefore we would like to express our gratitude for these financial contributions, without which we would not be able to fill our library with quality books and improve facilities of the library. We hope that this cooperation will continue and other departments will join in, so that we may provide satisfying quantity and quality of literature from their fields of study as well.

Moreover, our library represents more than just documents either in paper or electronic form. Basic skills of each student should also include information literacy, an ability to find information and analyze it. Therefore we offer courses for students to master the work with library catalogue and electronic databases. We have been cooperating with the Department of Geoinformatics in this regard for quite a long time. Gradually other departments have started to use our courses and we believe that the number of departments willing to educate their students in information retrieval with us will continue to grow. Our goal is to provide the basic course of information retrieval for all students of our faculty.

The second call to support a proof-of-concept activities at PU

Rector of Palacký University prof. Jaroslav Miller has announced the second call to support proof-of-concept (PoC) activities at our university on 3rd October 2014. The PoC projects are a part of the GAMA projects of the Technology Agency of the Czech Republic. PoC acitivities are aimed to support research activities leading to commercial application. Results of activities and research must have a high commercial potential and potential use on an existing market. The budget for individual projects amounts to CZK 200.000 – 800.000 for a period of 6–36 months. The activities or projects can be submitted only by those PU employees or students of Doctoral Study Programs who will be employed or studying at UP throughout the entire duration of the project. Data administration in OBD database

It is possible to insert outputs of OPEC projects to the personal bibliographic database (<u>OBD</u>), if applicable (e.g. POST UP projects).

It is necessary to insert one project result at the minimum as an output of a contract research into the OBD; the result must be dedicated exclusively. Contract research, which won't be paired with the outcome of the OBD will not be accepted.

OBD Training

Department of Science and Research at PU Rectorate offers a course of OBD training – application reporting, monitoring and presentation of publishing activities of PU employees. The course is intended to new employees who are responsible for OBD at individual departments of faculties. Based on information from Vice-Rector Ulrichová at the meeting of Vice-Deans, we address project managers of IGA Grants 2014 whose fund drawing is not in accordance with the plan to take appropriate actions and avoid possible under-spending.

Information about the conditions of drawing financial support for teacher training courses within the Erasmus Sub-Program +

Conditions of funding of employee mobility within Erasmus Sub-Program+ has changed. We kindly ask our employees for cooperation and respect for the new program rules.

The new program will fund all travel expenses while respecting certain efficiency rules. Their brief overview is given below.

- Funds will be paid out after submission of a Subscriber Contract.
- Funds will be paid out for course days plus one day immediately before and one day immediately after the course as days of travel.
- It is necessary to choose the cheapest possible way of travelling. The use of air travel is possible for reaching locations more than 500 km away.
- Travelling by car is possible only upon prior approval of Department of International Relations, Rectorate, Mrs. Y. Vyhnánková. The reimbursement will be paid out in the amount of a 2nd class train ticket upon confirmation of České dráhy.
- You ought to use a 3* hotel for an accommodation. Accommodation expenses will be paid out in the amount reaching up to maximum 90 EUR per night.
- Reimbursement for meals shall be paid out accordingly to the current Provision determining the base rate of foreign subsistence for the calendar year.
- The stay within the Erasmus program shall not give entitlement to an allowance.
- A travel order should be processed before signing the Subscriber Contract (previously the Financial Agreement).
- In order to allow realization of the greatest possible number of stays a preliminary cost calculation of travel expenses shall be submitted to Mrs. Vyhnánková before signing the Subscriber Contract. Calculation of

travel expenses with quantifying individual items shall be filled in a chart, which you can find in <u>Attachment no.1</u>. The cost calculation will be used for interim orientation in the overall budget spending. There won't be any reductions of financial support done on the basis of the cost calculation.

- A valid travel order form with all essentials and signatures shall be submitted in advance to a respective person at individual departments before every foreign trip.
- In order to execute your travel order it is necessary to give a copy of the Subscriber Contract to Mrs. Vyhnánková.
- It is not possible to leave for a foreign visit without signing the Subscriber Contract and executed travel order.
- In order to process the travel order all properly filled out travel documents have to be prepared. Documents shall be legible (stamps, signatures, amounts and currency), glued on a blank sheet of paper (A4) without overlapping each other and categorized according to the type of expenses and currency.
- Additional costs mainly consist of the public transport tickets in place of the training course. The cost of books, copying, museum or library entrances, etc. can't be part of the travel order documents.
- A request for a refund must be submitted to Mrs. Soldánová, Department of International Relations, Rectorate no later than 30 days after the end of the journey, 10th December 2014 at the latest for this calendar year.

Recruitment for State Office for Nuclear Safety, Prague

State Office for Nuclear Safety in Prague offers **two working positions: Inspector of Department for the Prohibition of Biological Weapon Control.** Activity of the department is focused on the performance of state supervision over the management of the defined biological agents and toxins.
