Introductory word

Dear readers,

There are currently about a hundred researchers, academic workers, and Ph.D. students from abroad working at the Faculty. The international feel has been noticeable especially in both regional research centers in Holice or at the Department of Optics, where cooperation with foreign partners as well as creating suitable conditions for hosting the "cream of the crop" of scientific world is an absolute normality. According to the University's Annual Report, there were 170 academic workers with foreign citizenship in 2013 working at UP. Our faculty was responsible for as much as one third of them. This could lead to an assumption that we have contributed enough to the internationalization process desired by the University Management. If only the situation was that simple.

One of the very important components of international cooperation is student mobility. Thanks to Erasmus and other programs about 80 students of the Faculty are headed abroad this year. Coming from abroad to stay and study at our Faculty are only 16 students. To try to balance this rather unfavorable ratio will be one of the most important tasks of the new Vice-dean for International Matters – Zdeněk Hradil, who has been appointed a month ago. He started preparing a list of courses available in English language. It is each department's responsibility what they have to offer to international students. These courses may be a first step leading to accrediting complete study programs in English, which are currently very limited on the bachelor's and master's level, and there are only 4 paying international students. Both steps should foster the Faculty's reputation in the world.

We not only need to lure students and researchers from abroad to Olomouc, however also provide suitable conditions for them to enjoy their stay and perhaps want to stay here for longer periods of time. "We have to further develop international atmosphere, so that foreigners do not feel left out. It means communicating both in Czech and English, and make information easily reachable" the Vice-dean annunciated. The next important step will be improving the English version of the Faculty website

An alert about entering the premises of the faculty using electronic cards and permission to enter and park your vehicle

Anonymous electronic cards which used to secure entrance to the faculty building at Envelopa and in Holice and were given out to external co-workers or tenants who have terminated their cooperation with the faculty will be deactivated as of January 31st. - 1) Card number
- 2) First and last name of the person to whom the card was issued
- 3) Name of the department/employer
- 4) Which areas you wish to have access to (door number/room number/building)
- 5) Validity of the card (expiration date)
- We also wish to inform about the change in door security passwords in Envelopa. Secretaries of each department will be asked to provide the current password and to define a new one during February. The change in coding will happen in the afternoon, however the specific date will be announced ahead of time. Entrance to the departments may be activated also on students' cards as well as part-time workers. Access may be limited to certain time periods of the day, or certain days of the week. CVT is in charge of issuing and activating electronic cards upon approval by the Head of the department.
