# Introductory word

The summer semester is upon us, and one of the first larger events of the faculty is "Window to practice". This year it is already the eighth time when representatives of companies working in natural science fields talk to students about the internships and future job opportunities. The event will take place on  $17^{th} - 18^{th}$  February. The first day is devoted to Mathematics, Physics, and Optics; the second day is focused on Biology, Chemistry, and Ecology. A record-high number of potential employers have confirmed their participation. A total of 34 companies' representatives will introduce their requirements for job applicants, levels of salaries, the hiring procedure, and career development possibilities. An essential part of the program will be interviews with the employers who will answer students' questions on individual basis at their booths in the foyer of the second floor of the faculty building on 17. listopadu. Students may also write their questions ahead of time <a href="here">here</a> and make sure that their queries will be answered. Students' participation is free of charge and there will be small refreshments and gifts available for active students.

Effective work with graduates has been a long-term priority of the faculty, and we hope that this event will successfully contribute to this tradition.

# Flow Analysis XIII international conference

Conference focused on analytical methods, automation using low-pressure flow systems etc. will take place from 5<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> July 2015 in Diplomat Hotel in Prague. Delegates from the Czech Republic are granted a considerable discount on registration fee which is not mentioned on the conference website. Academic or research worker will pay CZK 6000 and a student CZK 4000. This fee covers the scientific program, meals and conference materials. Projects preparation in the Operational Programme Research, Development and Education (OP VVV)

A meeting of the Coordination Council for preparation of projects in the OP VVV was held on 27<sup>th</sup> January. Only projects approved by faculty management both in the phase of intention and in the final form, and checked by PS UP, may be submitted. It is very likely that in the first call only one project for the whole UP will be submitted – in Priority Axis 2. Date of approval of OP VVV program at European Commission is not yet known. Due to coordination of the projects, their relation to the Strategic Plan UP and possible links with the strategy of ITI (Integrated Territorial Investment - 7 selected regions within the Czech Republic), it is necessary to do a preliminary screening of the projects and priorities within the faculty. 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Innovation vouchers are a financial tool that allows companies to obtain a subsidy up to 85% of the total cost of 200 000 CZK excluding VAT (depending on region) for various testing, analysis and measurement in specialized departments of universities. These vouchers can be applied to the payment of professional services, e.g. feasibility studies, appropriateness of material analysis, prototyping, technology audit, access to research facilities and optimizing operational processes of the company.
