ntroductory word

Faculty of Science has a stable number of applicants each year. This year was no exemption with about 3,900 applications delivered to the Study Department for the upcoming academic year. The idea for the future, however, is to slightly decrease the number of enrolled students and focus on picking the most qualified applicants.

High-school graduates have in the long term been interested in majors such as Biochemistry, Biotechnology, and Genetic Engineering. This trend continued also this year plus there has been a record high increase in applicants to study Molecular and Cell Biology. There were 213 applicants last year, this year 248 applications have been turned in. Other popular majors are Computer Science, Applied Mathematics in Banking and Insurance Business, or some majors from Earth Sciences. Combined majors of teaching and Biology still continue to be quite attractive.

"We are very pleased that there has been an increase in the key teachers' combination Mathematics – Physics. It seems like the popularizing activities are starting to pay off, as we received 27 applications this year compared to 13 last year. However, we are aware of the fact that this is a long distance race," Roman Kubínek (Vice-Dean for Study, Education and Social Matters) summarized.

The Faculty plans on enhancing the quality of enrolled students, not mere quantity. Approximately 900 students fall under the "excessive" category for which there is no government subsidy. Even though some students leave after the first year of their studies, they bring financial and administrative burden to the Faculty for the time they are studying.

"We strive to choose the best applicants who come with a particular interest already, e.g. those who participated in high-school competitions and Olympiads, and they wish to successfully complete their studies here," Kubínek confirmed. According to him it is more frequent for students of majors which do not require an entrance exam to drop out.

Every year there are more than 1,400 students enrolling into the first year of Bachelor and 500 into the first year of Master study programs. The Faculty is accounting for the second round of admissions procedure, however, this year only at study fields which do not have a filled capacity.

## Dean's Award for student scientific papers

# Instructions for outbound Erasmus students

Outbound Erasmus students shall send the Learning Agreement or Changes to Learning Agreement to the relevant coordinator of the department for an approval. The coordinator will then forward the document to the Head of the Department of Study to secure the Vice-Dean signature. Student will receive the scan of the signed document.

Students travelling abroad to work or study shall report the day of their departure and arrival to the Head of the Department of Study.

# cademic Senate

Academic Senate of the Faculty of Science approved this year budget on its last meeting on 1<sup>st</sup> April. Contribution from institutional funds will be about 23 million higher compared to the previous year. The faculty may calculate with the amount of 481.9 million CZK in total. Institutional funds which are divided by the Academic senate form roughly a half of the amount of the Faculty budget for each year. Other financial means are gained from purposive financial resources, projects, and grants. Last year the faculty was managing the amount of CZK 1.25 billion.
