ntroductory word

A Development project to support international staff, first contributions to support a more international environment paid out to departments, Czech language for foreigners, and creating an independent position of an Officer for international study affairs. These are examples of concrete steps of the Faculty management in order to make studying and working here more accessible.

Faculty of Science has been successful with the sustainability project of supporting existing post-doc positions. Thanks to this project, the faculty has obtained roughly CZK 7.8 million for financing the stays of foreign post-docs until the end of the year. "It gives us the opportunity to maintain positions of foreign academic staff participating in education since 2010 when they started working at Operational programs for Education and Competitiveness and Development and Innovations projects. These funds will cover half of the salary costs, the other half will be paid by the relevant "mother" department, "Zdeněk Dvořák (Vice-Dean for Research and Development matters) explained. Supported post-docs have to teach at least 30 hours and publish a paper in an impacted journal from July to December 2015.

This year's faculty budget accounts for about CZK 7.6 million to be spent on the support of internationalization. It is 10 % from the total amount of institutional funds acquired by the faculty in the K factor (quality, performance). The money is designated for departments actively involved in the internationalization program. First departments have already applied and received financial support for their teaching or employing foreigners. According to Z. Hradil (Vice-Dean for International Affairs) the subsidy has been paid out to the Department of Molecular Biology, C. R. Haná; Department of Analytical Chemistry, and Department of Developmental Studies. The total amount is CZK 660,000. There is also a selection of courses available in English language for foreign students – here. "We have welcomed two delegations from China – Soo-chow University and Southwest University, which are both keen to start student exchange programs," Hradi informed.

Foreign students will have a specialized officer for international study affairs at their disposal. The current Head of the Department of studies Mrs. Dana Gronychová will take over this agenda starting 1<sup>st</sup> July, and the current Head of the Library Jiří Mazal will take over the Department of studies.

In the following academic year, there will be a course of Czech language designated mainly for foreign employees and students of Doctoral study programs. "We are planning to form one group of 18 - 20 persons. We have an experienced instructor who has taught Czech for foreigners at the Medical faculty, and I sincerely hope her teaching style will soon attract further students, "Lucie Vaňková from the Department of Foreign Languages stated.

- We kindly request our teachers and subject guarantees to comply with conditions of PU Study and Examination Regulation, Article 20, especially with the following parts:
  - publication of examination dates in the STAG system no later than one week before the end of semester, paragraph 5
  - sufficient number of examination dates/exams, paragraph 6
  - an announcement of make-up exams for students who have not completed the subject in the subsequent examination period, paragraph 7
- The Department of Study reminds the third year students of Bachelor study programs and the second year students of Master study programs of the obligation to conclude their studies at least three weeks before the date of their state final examination. To conclude their studies, students must submit their student credit book with all their learning results written and confirmed in it at the Department of Study. The learning results must also be recorded in STAG system.
