ntroductory word

To seek out talented high-school students interested in Natural Sciences. That has been the Faculty's aim for several years now. The past few days have been very successful in this regard. A nineteen-year old student of a secondary grammar school in Zlín, Michaela Kajšová, who cooperates with the Department of Physical Chemistry, has been awarded at the world's largest competitions for young scientists Intel ISEF which took place in the USA. The young lady secured an invitation to this competition for 1700 students from more than 70 countries after having won the national round of High-school scientific activity in her category. She had been successful before in Badatel project, and has been cooperating with our researchers since 2013.

About a week ago there was another Young Scientists Conference. The Badatel section where high-school students can experience what scientific work at universities entails was highly represented this year. There were 24 participants with 19 presentations this year. Most of the research papers were supervised by our faculty research staff which we are very pleased to report. The evaluators praised the quality of research papers which sometimes came close to reaching the level of Bachelor or Master theses.

This type of events is highly valuable for talented young scientists. "Students get to explore the possibilities of research and realize that science is not boring. What is also important is that they get a chance to present their results in public and compare their presentation skills with others. These are important experiences they can use in the future. Many students participate in this competition repeatedly and they often end up studying at our factulty," Ludmila Zajoncová, the main conference organizer stated.

Her words were confirmed by Martin Vondrák from Slovanské gymnasium in Olomouc who has taken part in the conference several times before. At first he was tempted by Statistics then he took up Chemistry. He says that both



fields are equally intriguing. He sees his future Physical Chemistry. Although he still has one more year to decide what major he would like to study, he has already decided that he would study at the Faculty of Science. "I like the faculty very much, it is modern and well-equipped. I would also like to continue cooperating with people I already know," the student explains. A big thank you therefore goes to the supervisors who often have to start introducing their subjects from the very beginning. If the goal is to motivate the cream of the crop to study at our faculty then these activities may bring a significant contribution.

Information about the registration into higher grades of study programs

Students are obliged to submit checked and signed Registration list A and completed and signed Registration list for the next academic year 2015/16 in order to register. We kindly request students to put all the required documents in an envelope, and insert them into the white box in front of the Department of Study or post them but only after all their learning results are recorded in STAG system. After submitting Registration list A it is no longer possible to make any records to STAG.

Study programs extensions

The third year Bachelor study programs students and the second-year Master study programs students, who will not complete their study obligations to conclude their studies before the state final exams may apply for **study extension** at Department of Study. In order to do that, the third year Bachelor study programs students must have acquired at least 120 credits and successfully complete all subject registered for the second time. The second-year Master study programs students must have acquired a minimum of 80 credits and successfully complete all subject registered for the second time as well.

Graduation Ceremony

We kindly ask our students who will complete their studies by taking a state final exam and wish to participate in graduation ceremonies to come to Department of Study immediately after state examinations and confirm their presence at the graduation ceremony. Graduation ceremonies will be held on $23^{rd} - 26^{th}$ June.

Graduation ceremony of Doctoral study programs will be held on 12th June in the auditorium of the Faculty of Law at 10:00 a.m.

- We kindly request students of Doctoral study programs to deliver their student evaluation signed by the supervisor to Department of Study by 30th June. It must include Registration list for new academic year 2015/2016.
- We inform the first year students of Doctoral study programs about an obligation to acquire at least 40 credits till the end of current academic year and to submit signed specification of their dissertation theses at the same time.

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Students of Doctoral study programs who will not conclude their studies within the standard time frame shall submit their student evaluation signed by the supervisor and study extension application form including statement of the supervisor.

Summer opening hours of Department of Study

Department of study will be closed from 6th to 10th July and from 17th to 21st August. In the remaining days over the summer Department of Study will be open on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:00 to 11:00 a.m. and from 1:30 to 2:30 p.m.
