## Introductory word

Study fields of our faculty will be presented in the Stronghold of knowledge during the following five weeks. High-school students, their parents as well as other visitors may get acquainted with activities of various departments, learn information about admission procedure, and last but not least about the great achievements of local researchers. The series called "Month with Natural Sciences" will start with Biology and Ecology and finish with Physics in mid-December.

"The goal of this event is to closely link activities of the faculty and the Stronghold of knowledge and introduce them to the public. We will present our study fields to visitors in a different environment than up to now. They will find out that at our faculty they can not only receive high-quality education, but they can become a part of top research teams. We hope to motivate talented high-school students to study natural sciences," the Dean, Ivo Frébort, explained.

Biology, Ecology, Earth Sciences, Chemistry, Mathematics, Computer Science, or Physics will be consecutively presented in the interactive museum of science. In many cases these so called "study field weeks" will be interconnected with other promotional activities of the departments, e.g. Open house at the Centre of the Region Haná or GISday at the Department of Geoinformatics.



Each of the five weeks will be devoted to one study field which will have a bulletin board and a stand on the ground floor of the museum. Thursdays will always be dedicated to presentations for high-school students where they may learn information about admissions, meet young scientists, listen to lectures on intriguing topics, and see exciting experiments. On Saturdays, there will be Science Café – lectures popularizing science for the general public taking place in Laudon's hall from 2 pm. Visitors will among other things learn that Mathematics is the language of natural sciences, get acquainted with the newest research results of Olomouc Ecologists from Borneo or with the climate in Olomouc. Babysitting will be available during these lectures.

"Interconnecting the Stronghold of knowledge with the Faculty of Science is visible also when visiting the exhibitions, which were for a large part created with the help of scientist from the faculty. We want people to know that we attend to popularization of science throughout the whole year," the Program Director of the museum, Jakub Ráliš stated.

The "study field weeks" should not substitute for the traditional open house events. On the contrary, they should serve as an invitation to these. An open house where student candidates may get to know the authentic environment of the lecture rooms and laboratories will take place on November 20 and January 16.

- Announcement for the first-year students of the Master study program in teaching A teaching internship for the first-year students as well as students of the parallel complementary study of teaching will be taking place next year **from February 29 to March 18**. An application form for teaching internship is available on the website of the Centre of Pedagogical Training, the Faculty of Science. Registered students only may enter the continuous teaching internship. Applications shall be submitted **by January 22**.

The center of Pedagogical Training places students to schools in Olomouc and nearby towns (Šternberk, Přerov, Prostějov, Uničov, Litovel). Students do not have to ensure the internship at these schools by themselves; however, they may specify the name of the preferred school in Olomouc region in the application. Students who wish to practice their skills in different regions shall ensure their internship position by themselves. It is necessary to ask the director of the school to approve the internship on their application form.
