ntroductory word

Do you ever feel like processing your financial documents at the Economic department of the Faculty is taking a long time? Maybe the following numbers will bring new light upon the issue. As the turnover of the Faculty has doubled in the past five years from CZK 560 million in 2009 to last year's CZK 1,25 billion, it is obvious that not only has the number of documents risen, but the procedure of their administration has become more complex.

"Processing financial documents is getting more and more complex. While many things used to be done at once, nowadays we have to calculate VAT, separate payments onto different accounts, departments etc. What used to be done by one procedure now the accountant has to do in five steps," the Secretary Jana Zimová informed.

In 2009 there were 21,684 documents which went through the Economic department, in 2012 there were about 10,000 more, and last year their number came up to 37,172. These documents included 94,495 items. There are nowadays also many more cash register documents. While there used to be 6,623 of them in 2010, there were 8,972 cash register documents filed last year.

"In 2014 the time consumption of each document has risen by approximately 50 %. The reason for that is the newly implemented rule for VAT assertion which requires more steps in order to control and process the documents," Lenka Copková of the Grant support department clarified.

The highest amount of work for the administrative workers comes in the last two months of the year. Out of 12,155 invoices from last year 26 % were processed in November and December, which has been a long-term tendency. However, the total amount of invoices was lower in the previous years. "I would like to ask the relevant employees not to leave everything up to the last minute. It only leads to more pressure, stress, and mistakes are made," Jana Zimová said. Only one additional accountant has joined the department since 2013.

Confirmation of study

If you want to speed up the process of the confirmation study approval issuing print out the blank form yourself. To access the form, log into the PU Portal. Than use a path: **Studium a výuka – Moje studium – Průběh studia**. Find the form called **Formulář pro tisk potvrzení o studiu** at the bottom of the page. Complete the blank form and bring it to the Department of Study for confirmation.

aculty Operation

- As of 13th February 2015 all printers, copying and scanning machines shall no longer be ordered through DYNAS. The equipment has to be purchased with invoice and in accordance with internal rules. Orders for purchase exceeding 5,000 CZK shall be processed in SAP system and provided with signature of the Secretary.
- As of 27th February 2015 all office supplies except of paper and envelopes shall no longer be ordered through DYNAS. Its purchase proceeds according to the same inner rules as purchase of other equipment.
- Office paper and envelopes shall be ordered based on the current framework agreement with Office Systems, s.r.o. Prostějov. It has to be purchased with an invoice and in accordance with internal purchasing rules as well.
- For ordering PCs, laptops and toners you should keep using DYNAS.

Registered consignments and mail packages

Registered incoming and outgoing consignments are no longer accepted at the faculty reception, they will be dealt with at the registry. Therefore secretaries of all departments are kindly requested to check registered consignments in Magion system, as it is the only way to find out that they had received a registered consignment.

- Packages are henceforth accepted at the reception. Each package must bear the name of the department and contact person otherwise it will be returned to the carrier. Each package will be handed over to the respective person against signature.
- Delivery of private packages to employees and students of the faculty is prohibited. It is not within the janitors' capability, nor responsibility to accept for the COD delivery.

Is your bicycle parked in the parking garage at Envelopa?

The bicycle shed in the garage has been built for safe storage of bikes used to get to/from work. If you have left your bike in the garage over the winter season make sure you take it away till the end of March. The Department of Technical Support will mark all bikes parked in the garage for a long period of time, and they will be moved out at the end of the month to free up parking spaces for those who actually use bikes to get to work.

Access to the underground parking garage

Access to the underground parking garage at Envelopa building will be enabled only to owners of cars, motorcycles, and bicycles. Access of all other employees who use the way through garage door as a short cut to their workplace will be blocked. Access will be provided upon a written application submitted to the head of the Department of Thechnical Support, Dagmar Zlámalová, e-mail: <u>dagmar.zlamalova@upol.cz</u>. It will be bound to a parking card. To enter the main faculty building at Envelopa at the weekends and national holidays, use the entrance from 17. listopadu street. If the front door is locked, ring the bell to the reception (the bell door communicator in the entrance of the main building).
