ntroductory word

In a previous Newsletter we reported about construction works that await us next year at the Envelopa faculty premises. Today we would like to draw your attention to the Holice campus, where the faculty management plans the first stage of reconstruction of communications and technical infrastructure, building alterations of an energocentre, completion and repair of building No. 52 and construction of site for compost management.

Staff and students in Holice campus are likely to be most affected by the reconstruction of communications and technical infrastructure; the first stage of construction works will commence in May 2017. However the major constraints caused by construction works should end by the beginning of the winter semester. The entire reconstruction will continue to mid-2018. The cost is estimated at CZK 27 million and will be disbursed from the central University funds.



"We plan to reconstruct the whole main street, communication leading to UP Science and Technology Park as well as other adjacent roads and sidewalks in the campus. We will also build new parking spaces and green areas. We are very well aware of difficulties our students and employees will have to face due to construction works carried out in full faculty operation. But the reconstruction will result in newly paved pedestrian zone too. Reconstruction of technical infrastructure including sewerage system which is in disrepair, will be realized in parallel", said the Secretary, Jana Zimová.

Building alterations of an energocentre is another investment planned. Servers in Holice ensure operation of the entire faculty. The server room does not meet the requirements for capacity nor the technical equipment. Therefore, the Computer Centre of Palacký University shall purchase new server and we will invest approximately CZK 6 mil. to adapt the building, which will also be used to place an alternative power source and relocated telephone exchanges. We have claimed the whole investment of approximately CZK 10 mil. in terms of the European Regional Development Fund. We would like to prepare construction project during next year and start the reconstruction in March 2018", said Jana Zimová

Reconstruction of building No. 52 will also begin in the next year in order to create space for detached workplace of the Dean's office and Building maintenance staff. Estimated costs amount CZK 25 million.

Construction of site for compost management which is situated behind energocentre of Regional Centre of Advanced Technologies and Materials should be completed in spring.

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An extension and refurbishment of the ground floor of the building No. 47 as well as refurbishment of infrastructure for practical training are further construction works planned in Holice campus. Their realization is involved in projects submitted in terms of Operational Program Research, Development and Education. We would know in spring whether faculty succeeded in applicable project calls.
