Introductory word

Czech Science Foundation has published a list of projects that succeeded in public calls of this institution in 2016. The Faculty of Science will benefit from financial support of 13 successful standard projects and three junior grants. Altogether 30 standard projects from Palacký University succeeded in individual calls of the Czech Science Foundation, the junior grants have only been granted to the Faculty of Science.

"I would like to congratulate all our successful applicants and to thank everyone else involved in project preparation. Twelve standard projects were supported from CSF funds last year; this year's results prove that we maintain a stable position, "said the Dean, Ivo Frébort.

In this year's competition 33,1% of standard projects and 36,5% of junior grants were successful. The success rate of standard project of the Faculty of Science amounts to 29.5%; a total of 44 of them were sent from our faculty. A total of 10 junior project proposals were submitted by young scientists, only three of which succeeded. The Faculty of Science has clearly overtaken other faculties of Palacký University by the number of successful project applications. The Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry received support of five standard projects. The Faculty of Law and the Faculty of Arts both identically received support of four standard projects, while the Faculty of Education succeeded with two project applications. The Faculty of Physical Culture and the Sts Cyril and Methodius Faculty of Theology submitted one successful standard project each.
