ntroductory word

Research centers of Palacký University have once again proven that among 48 newly established scientific facilities in the Czech Republic supported by European funding they belong to the most active in publishing their research results. Regional Centre of Advanced Technologies and Materials (RCPTM) has ended on the second and the Centre of the Region Haná for Biotechnological and Agricultural Research (CRH) on the sixth place according to evaluation published by Lidové noviny (LN). A similar report was published by the same paper in December 2014.

The results have pleased the Dean and Director of CRH Ivo Frébort. "We have been doing great thanks to excellent researchers and their diligence and enthusiasm. At CRH, we should however step up, so that we are not the last ones in Olomouc," he said with a smile.

A "map" of research centers has been created based on data from Web of Science database. Among the most active centers as far as publications is also the Institute of Molecular and Translational Medicine of the Medical Faculty which finished on the fourth place. According to analysis done by LN, three research centers from Olomouc contribute by 23,7 % of publications and by 45,7 of citations! "Higher number of publications is achieved only by Brno (41,5 %). However, with less number of citations," wrote Martin Rychlik, the editor.

The first place from last year was again claimed by Central European Institute of Technology (CEITEC). With its 2,454 published papers it has no competition also considering its size and links to Masaryk University and Brno University of Technology. Its studies were cited in 12,464 cases by the end of last year. Right after CEITEC came RCPTM, which may be proud of its 1,343 published papers and incredible 19,000 citations. Researchers at CRH published 472 papers, which have been cited 4091 times.



"The entire operation program involves more than just publications and citations. It is also about sustainability and multiple resources of financing without having to rely on other special financial aid. Of course, excellent papers bring interesting money from institutional financing, however they are the building block of high quality applied research," explains Radek Zbořil, Director of RCPTM. In his opinion research centers have to succeed not only in national projects but acquire large EU grants such as Horizon 2020. Other possibility for sustainable financing is income from contractual research and licensing. CEITEC and RCPTM are also the only new research institutes which managed to acquire prestigious ERC grants. Michal Otyepka who received the grant in Olomouc explains that it is impossible to compare citation response of e.g. Physical Chemistry with Mechanical Engineering. "Evaluating the quality of research is a very complex issue. One of the possible measures we use in scientometry is citation response analysis. It is however a complex characteristics, and apart from its quality it can also reflex the popularity of the field, or number of scientists working in the field," says Otyepka.
