Thanks to excellent scientific results the Faculty of Science will be better off again

Faculty of Science will this year be better off financially mainly due to its top scientific performance. The contribution of institutional resources has increased by CZK 27 million compared to last year. The Faculty can count on a total amount of approximately CZK 509 million. On Wednesday's Faculty Academic Senate meeting 17 out of 19 present Academic Senate members voted in favor of the distribution of funds.

"The rise of scientific performance of our Faculty is very distinctive in comparison with other faculties which I am truly happy about. In most workplaces, there is a slight increase in funding compared to the previous year. Thanks to this increase we will also be able to secure operation of the Stronghold of knowledge and ensure its sustainability in the upcoming years," said the Dean - Ivo Frébort. The Centre of popularization will this year manage the budget of approximately CZK 11 million, with almost CZK 5 million from the Dean's Office funds.

The largest part from the obtained institutional contribution is for results in science and research. While last year the Faculty received CZK 225.3 million, this year the contribution for science and research amounted to CZK 254.8. The Faculty received roughly CZK 1 million higher contribution for teaching according to coefficient K (quality, performance), which comes to about CZK 77 million. On the contrary, the contribution for funded students has decreased again by roughly CZK 3 million to CZK 177 million. Contribution of the Faculty to University activities will increase. While last year it was less than CZK 90 million, this year it will come to CZK 91.5 million.



The Academic Senate has approved the report on the Faculty's economy in 2015 as well as the methodology of division of the funds, which compared with the previous year has undergone only small adjustments. When allocating contributions for teaching, the total number of students shall be decreased by first-year students of the Bachelor's and follow-up Master's programs who fail to obtain any credits by February 15 of the respective year. A novelty comes also in form of a one-off contribution to the salary costs of Post-doc staff from a project called "Sustainability of Post-doc positions at UP". "This contribution is about 80,000 crowns, which should cover three months-worth of salary at the beginning of the calendar year, when the workplaces do not have grant funds at their disposal," explained Frébort.

The report on Faculty's economy in 2015 and the budget for 2016 have been recommended for approval also by the Economic Commission of the Faculty Senate. "The Economic Commission states that the Division of funds is in accordance with the approved methodology, and therefore recommends its adoption," said the Commission's Chairwoman Irena Smolová.

Institutional funds redistributed the Academic Senate make up for about half of the amount the Faculty disposes of. The additional money comes from special purpose funds, projects and grants. In 2014 the Faculty operated on a budget of CZK 1.25 billion, last year with about CZK 1.1 billion.

Student lockers are currently more accessible

Students who would like to use one of 390 lockers must now observe new rules. The storage spaces are intended solely for one day temporary storage of personal things; keys are available at the faculty front desk upon submission of their ISIC card.

"We are willing to provide more students with storage space. Until recently, many of the lockers were either permanently occupied, or their keys were missing. However, we have introduced a trial operation of our new system. After the trial period, at the end of the academic year, we might consider adjustments," said the Secretary Jana Zimová.

Students may borrow a key after electronic registration using their ISIC card and store their belongings in the locker from 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. If a student does not return the key, our system will send a notification to the student's email. Should the student fail to return the key or explain why he/she has not been able to do so, the locker will be opened within two days and the left belongings will be kept in the faculty archive. In addition, the student will lose one of the three credits available for the whole time of study. After their depletion the system won't allow additional lending due to repeated violation of operating rules. Loss of a key is fined by CZK 500.

A similar system has also been implemented at Faculty of Medicine and libraries of the university or the Faculty of Physical Culture. Students' lockers Operating Rules will be available at the faculty front desk, at the lockers and on the faculty website in the upcoming days.
