The Minister of Education, Youth and Sports Kateřina Valachová will visit the Faculty of Science during her official stay in Olomouc Region on May 5. We would like to cordially invite all students and teachers to the debate with the minister focused mainly on the issues related to the operation of universities. The debate will be held in the auditorium of the faculty from 2:10 p.m.



"Specific needs of different regions are easier to determine when I actually visit the area. I believe that received information will be a valuable inspiration for further work including comments on currently addressed legislation," Valachová stated.

The minister will also visit the primary school in Dolany, the grammar school Čajkovského in Olomouc and moreover she has accepted an invitation of the rector Jaroslav Miller for a short discussion at the same day.

Finish your studies on time if you want to take the state final examination!

The Department of Study reminds the third year students of Bachelor study programmes and the second year students of Master study programmes of the obligation to conclude their studies at least three weeks before the date of their state final examination. To conclude their studies, students must submit student

credit book with all their learning results entered and confirmed therein at the Department of Study. The learning results must also be recorded in STAG system.

Graduation Ceremony

We kindly ask students who will complete their studies by taking a state final exam in May or June and wish to participate in graduation ceremonies to come to the Department of Study and confirm their presence at the graduation ceremony. Graduation ceremony will be held from **June 27 to July 1**. Graduation schedule will be posted on the website of the Faculty. Graduation fee is CZK 500 and can be paid using a money order or a bank transfer. The account number is 19-1096330227 / 0100, payment reference number is 99310031. Write a word "Graduation" in message for recipient, please. In both means of payment please send a scanned copy of the proof of payment to the relevant employee at the Department of study.

Students, who completed their studies by taking a state final exam in January and February, can collect their diplomas at the Department of Study. We kindly request faculty alumni, who will take part in the graduation ceremony (June 27 – July 1) to deliver their diplomas back to the Department of Study before the graduation in order to obtain them during the ceremony.

Announcement for the first-year students of the Master study programme in teaching

A teaching internship for the first-year students as well as students of the parallel complementary study of teaching will be taking place next year **from September 26 to October 14**. An application form for teaching internship is available on the website of the Centre of Pedagogical Training, the Faculty of Science. Only registered students may enter the continuous teaching internship. Applications shall be submitted **by September 2**.

The Centre of Pedagogical Training places students to schools in Olomouc and nearby towns (Šternberk, Přerov, Prostějov, Uničov, Litovel). Students do not have to ensure the internship at these schools by themselves; however, they may specify the name of the preferred school in Olomouc region in the application. Students, who wish to practice their skills in different regions, shall ensure their internship position by themselves. It is necessary to ask the director of the school to approve the internship in their application form.

- We would like to inform that Article II, paragraph 2 of the Reimbursement of Costs Contract has been revised recently. Newly, names of a respective department and a responsible person must be added to the contract. The current version of the document is available on the faculty webpage in the Forms for the Economic Department section.
- Delivery of private consignments to employees and students of the faculty is prohibited
- We kindly request our employees to forward all electronically received invoices to the rectorate at faktury@upol.cz. The documents will be registered in IS Magion and only then transferred to the faculty registry node.
- Important documents which you wish to send via internal mail shall be handed over directly to the hands of registry staff or to the hands of the faculty janitors with necessary instructions.
- All outbound correspondence consigned from the faculty registry must bear a stamp of respective department in order to allow appropriate postage accounting and correct records in Magion.
- As of May 1 the Czech Post will increase fees for ordinary and registered consignments. We will now pay from one to four crowns more for posting internal as well as foreign shipments.
- We kindly request employees who work with IS Magion to continuously proceed all documents electronically too. If there are upending documents older than one year in the system, the concerned departments might face a fine of up to CZK 500 000. Older backlog of electronic documents must be

assigned with discarding characters and archived. Mr. Jaroslav Bič from the Rectorate can provide training upon request.

All faculty departments can currently use only **one valid customer number for sending consignments via TNT Express, which is 110336**. All the others were cancelled in terms of the recent revision. We kindly request our staff to stop creating new faculty customer numbers. Faculty management will gradually implement similar revisions of customer numbers for other transport companies as well.
