ntroductory word

Successful project applications within Research, Development and Education Operational Programme have been initiated at the Faculty of Science. Representatives of six departments are involved in three large didactic projects. The RCPTM project focusing on development of hybrid nanomaterials for applications in renewable energy sources has won the biggest financial support so far. The evaluation process of RCPTM and CRH Excellent Research projects looks promising as well.

The university project called Supporting internships as an instrument to develop practical teaching skills has started in early November. Our faculty is in charge of a specific objective called Man and Nature. Elementary school teachers of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Geography and Maths are the target group of the project. "Video recordings of their lessons will serve as a basis for teachers' evaluation. We aim to provide additional teaching alternatives and valuable feedback afterwards. Teachers may also attend our sample lessons at the Stronghold of Knowledge and Sluňákov ecological center," said Jan Říha from Department of Experimental Physics, who is in charge of this activity. Approximately 20 academics from our faculty will take part in the project during upcoming years. Project subsidy amounts up to CZK 9 mil.

Our faculty has also been involved in University of Ostrava project called PŘÍRODA with a similar objective and financial subsidy since the beginning of this year. This project focuses on strengthening competences of primary school science teachers using videoconferences and short motivational videos this time.

Making teaching science at primary schools more attractive is the aim of another project which our faculty is involved in. University of West Bohemia in Pilsen in cooperation with three more universities, elementary school teachers and nonprofit organizations is going to create a community of practical teaching skills to carry out research of new learning methods and forms of teaching as well as to give suggestions on the innovation of educational units.

RCPTM has succeeded in competition with more than a hundred "excellent team" projects. Realization of the winning project may bring significant progress in development of technologies that enable effective splitting of water molecules and obtaining hydrogen as a major sustainable energy source. The issue is addressed in a team led by world-respected scientist in the field of Material Chemistry, Photochemistry and renewable energy, Patrik Schmuki. Both faculty research centers have also been closely monitoring the evaluation process of Excellent Research projects. Among 130 applicants their projects have received high ranking in the first round of evaluation.

Ignaz L. Lieben Award 2017

The Ignaz L. Lieben Award is granted to young scientists who have been working in Austria, Bosnia-Herzegowina, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Hungary, Slovakia or Slovenia for the last 3 years. Eligible candidates shall not be older than 40, have completed their doctorate and have made outstanding achievements in scientific research in the field of molecular biology, chemistry or physics.
