The number of student applications recorded no significant changes compared to last year

The Faculty of Science experiences a stable interest of high school graduates. Department of Study has accepted a total of 3494 applications for the academic year 2017/2018. There were 3667 applications turned in last year. The annual decline is only about 200 applications for Bachelor study programs, the number of applications for follow-up Master Study programs has slightly increased.

"We are pleased that the anticipated lower number of high school graduates did not have a significant impact on us. We will see how many applicants will actually register; the number of admitted students will be the same as last year, " said Roman Kubínek, Vice-Dean for Study, Education and Social Matters.



The Faculty of Science offers more than a hundred study programs in different fields of Mathematics and Computer Science, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Earth Sciences. Department of Study received 2755 applications by the end of February; it is 197 less than in the last year. As in previous years, applicants are mainly interested in majors such as Molecular and Cell Biology with a total of 237 applications, Biochemistry with 181 applications or Experimental Biology. Environmental Studies and Sustainable Development has recorded the highest increase in a number of applications. 93 students chose the program this year. There were only 37 applications received in 2016.

On the contrary, Applied Computer Science recorded the biggest decline due to new criteria of admissions procedure this year. "Fewer students will enroll in this study program compared to the previous year. However, it will exclude students who do not obtain any credits during the first year of study and who generally applied for study programs without an entrance examination. And also it is consistent with the concept that we have set, "Kubínek stated.

Compared to the previous year the second round of the admissions procedure will be limited to Bachelor Study programs which will not reach their full capacity after the first round concerning mainly fields of Mathematics and Physics.

Palacký University accepted 25 444 applications by February 28. There were 27 899 applications turned in last year.
