Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme

SEE encourages high-calibre PhD candidates to apply for the prestigious Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme, which offers an attractive stipend and allowance for three years of studies in Hong Kong. Successful fellowship recipients applying through City University of Hong Kong will be awarded:

- a monthly stipend of HK\$20,000 (~US\$2,600) for three years;
- a conference and research-related travel allowance of HK\$10,000 (~US\$1,300) per year for three years; and
- the Chow Yei Ching School of Graduate Studies Entrance Scholarships of HK\$67,296 (~US\$8,620) during the first year to cover tuition and on-campus accommodation fees.

Additional scholarships and financial awards are available to qualified students for undertaking research-related activities, attending international conferences and extending to the fourth year for applicants without a master degree.





Application Procedures:

Step One:

Applicants should first submit an initial application at the RGC's Online Application System (OAS) at www.rgc.edu.hk/hkphd, and obtain a RGC reference number on or before 1 December 2014.

Step Two:

Applicants are then required to submit full application, together with supporting documents, to CityU's Online Admission System at www.cityu.edu.hk/sgs/oas, and quote the RGC reference number, on or before 6 December 2014.

Short-listed candidates will be invited for an admission interview (in person/by phone). Application results will be announced in March 2015.
